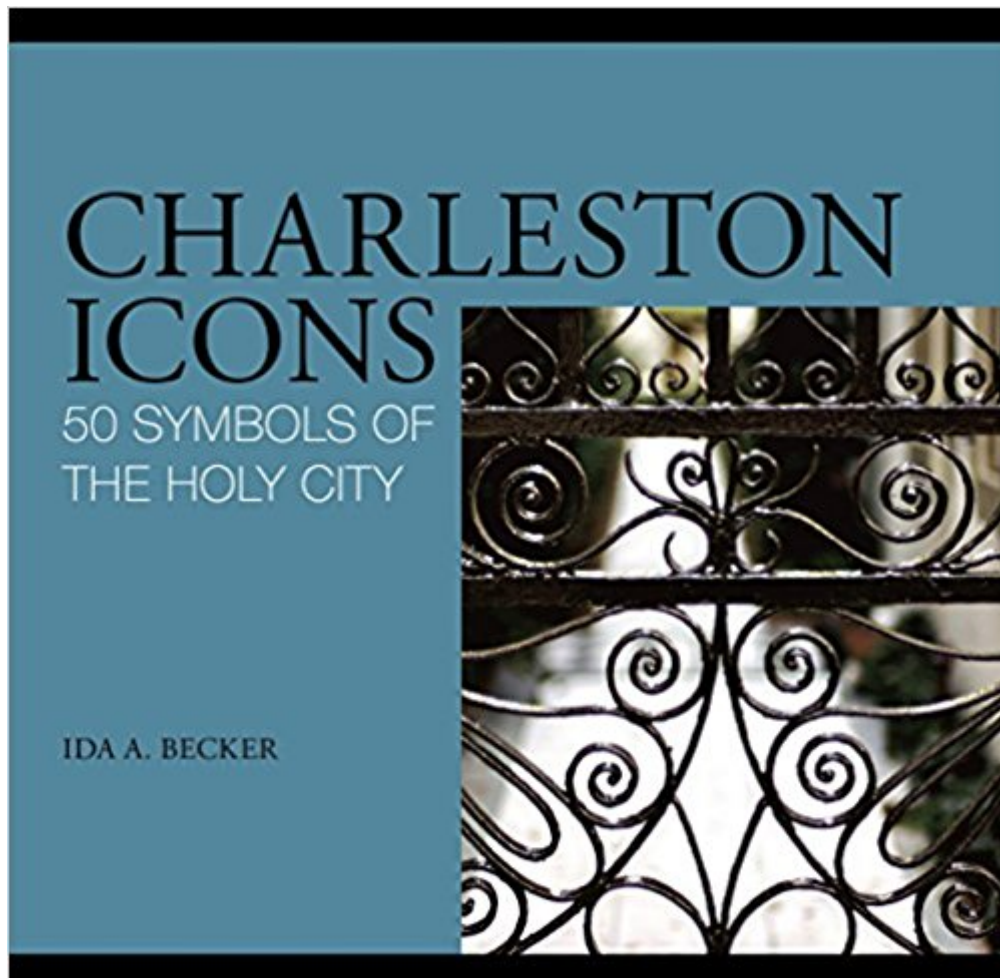




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Charleston Icons: 50 Symbols Of The Holy City
