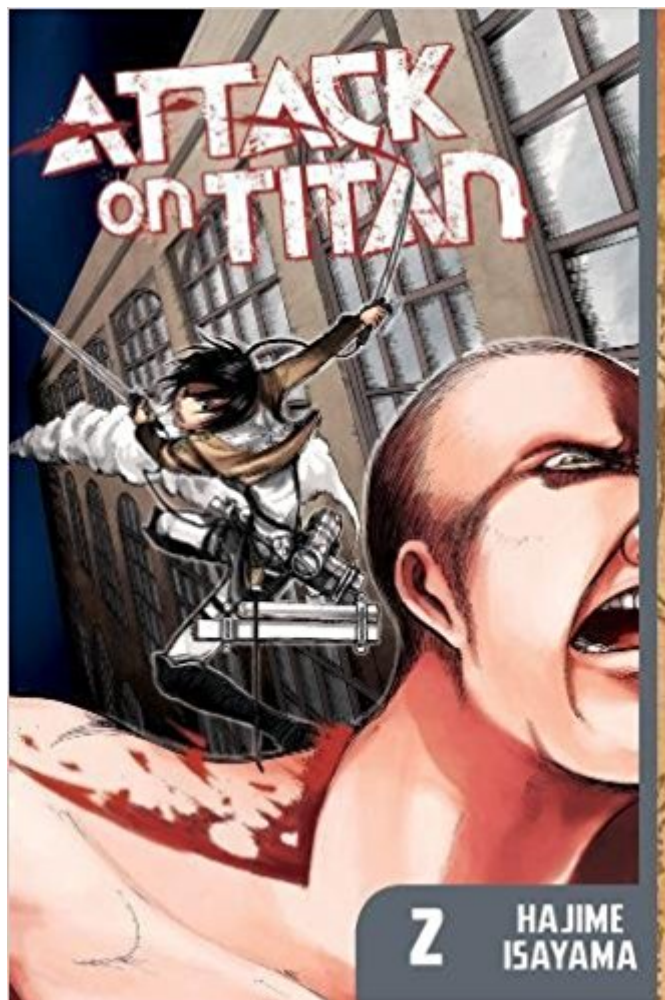


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Attack On Titan 2

This is interesting, since we don't know the extent of the titan's intelligence, motives, or goals, so it's nice to see a curveball. Speaking of curveballs, there's another shocking twist about the identity of this new titan.Overall, this is a fantastic volume. The artwork is spot-on, and there's a lot of character and story development.
