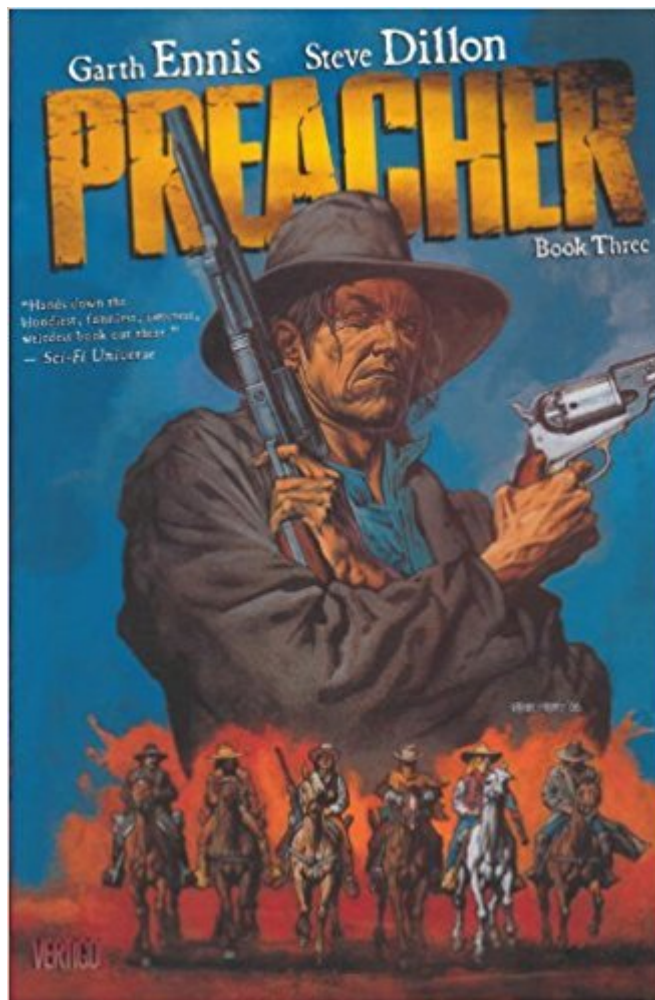

As well as PREACHER, his credits include HELLBLAZER, HITMAN, WAR STORY, ADVENTURES IN THE RIFLE BRIGADE, KEV, BATTLER BRITTON, The Boys, Battlefields, Dan Dare, 303, The Chronicles of Wormwood, Crossed, Streets of Glory, Dicks, The Punisher, Fury and The Pro. Originally hailing from Belfast, Northern Ireland, he now resides in New York City with his wife, Ruth.

Preacher is my favorite vertigo title of all time. I don't even remember why I bought the first issue, but I'm glad I did. The story of Jesse Custer, girlfriend Tulip and friend vampire, Cassidy, it's the

simple story of a man's search for God. Not the spiritual way, but actual God. And that all I can say. Get it. Read it. It's not for everyone, and it helps if one has a warped sense of humor, but it's worth reading! Again and again and again.
