I thought "Laurent and the Beast," the first book of the Kings of Hell MC was amazing, but this book is even better!! I believe this is the longest book by this author, but I gobbled it up so fast because I couldn't put it down. It was so good! This is the story of Knight and Elliott. Knight is the VP of the Kings of Hell MC, and Elliott, who is also The Count. The Count has a blog that devoted to the serial killer, William Fane, who is tied to the Kings of Hell clubhouse/asylum/haunted mansion. Knight is an avid genealogist, which is unusual for a big, bad, sexy biker. He has always been proud of his Mercier ancestry, enough to get his body covered in tattoos with names, dates, and even a battle scene. Knight has a big grudge against The Count because of his inaccurate stories and his idolizing of Fane. It doesn't seem a likely match between these two. BUT, the author is able to make it work beautifully. It isn't all love and roses, however. If you don't like blood and gore with your biker romance, you won't like this book. There are some really bloody and gory scenes. What else would you expect from a story of the Kings of Hell MC club, which includes a devil and several ghosts? I didn't like Elliott at the beginning of the book, but I came to love him by the end of the book. It was amazing how the authors developed these characters and the changes that come about in Knight and Elliott. Of course there is a HEA and I can't wait to read the next book in the series, "On Your Knees Prospect." This book can be read as a standalone, but you should read "Laurent and the

Beast" first to get a better idea of the back story. There are some mysteries that are partially revealed in this book that make you want to keep reading to discover more. I received an ARC in exchange for an honest review.

This has an absolutely amazing storyline continuing from a book I didn't know could get any better. This is everything I was hoping for and more besides! (Spoilers ahead) The only thing I can't get over is that Elliot isn't haunted if he just leaves the one building, and Knight makes a shady pact to save Elliot from this haunting... is it really so bad for Elliot to have a place nearby? Why not have the two of them move out of the club, even if means Knight has to go to the club every day as he would for work or something? It just gets to me that someone would make a lifelong pact when a reasonable solution is right there, or without at least doing some more research into this... But then again, that is exactly what keeps the storyline going and will have me curious what this gargoyle plans to do when he expands his capacity... Also I am curious about the role of several of the other ghosts... and Jake, what's up with him? I feel like he's probably met the gargoyle demon already.

The series contains violence and depravity but it works. You find yourself drawn to the characters and become invested in the outcome. Knight is truly a knight in every sense of the word and I love his strength and honour. Elliott is sweet but a total mixed up package. It was good to see recurring characters and I'm invested enough to want to order the next book. I have a soft spot for Jake and want to hear his story.

But so much of that changes when he finds The Count (Elliot) trespassing more than once and later comes to his rescue. Knight becomes distracted from his VP duties especially when the young Elliot is in constant need of rescuing. In the end Knight takes on Elliot as his responsibility feeling like he is the only one that can keep this young man safe. Little did he know taking on Elliot would bring both of these men more trouble than they both probably thought possible. Elliot is quite a lonely soul living in a rundown trailer. He is basically skin and bones barely being able to afford to feed himself. He makes his money from his youtube channel as The Count, where he chats about his obsession; William Fane. When he was a teen feeling misunderstood and lonely he found himself in a serial killer chat room where he met a group called, Faneatics. Here is where he learned of William Fane and the obsession began. Elliot romanticizes William and feels like he and William would have been a perfect fit. Elliot believes he has a connection with this serial killer and that the man is misunderstood. Oh, how wrong he is and soon finds out the hard way...To say the relationship between Knight and Elliot is complicated is an understatement. They are attracted to each other and have a deep connection. Elliot is completely enthralled by Knight, but Knight isn't the committing kind. Hell, he isn't even the kissing a boy kind. But the pull to Elliot is undeniable even if confusing for Knight. Elliot is needy and a bit of a brat. Knight is set in his ways and doesn't see them changing. So it leaves their "relationship" up in the air most of the time. What is undeniable is how sweet they are when they are together. Knight is swoon worthy in how he protects and takes care of Elliot.
