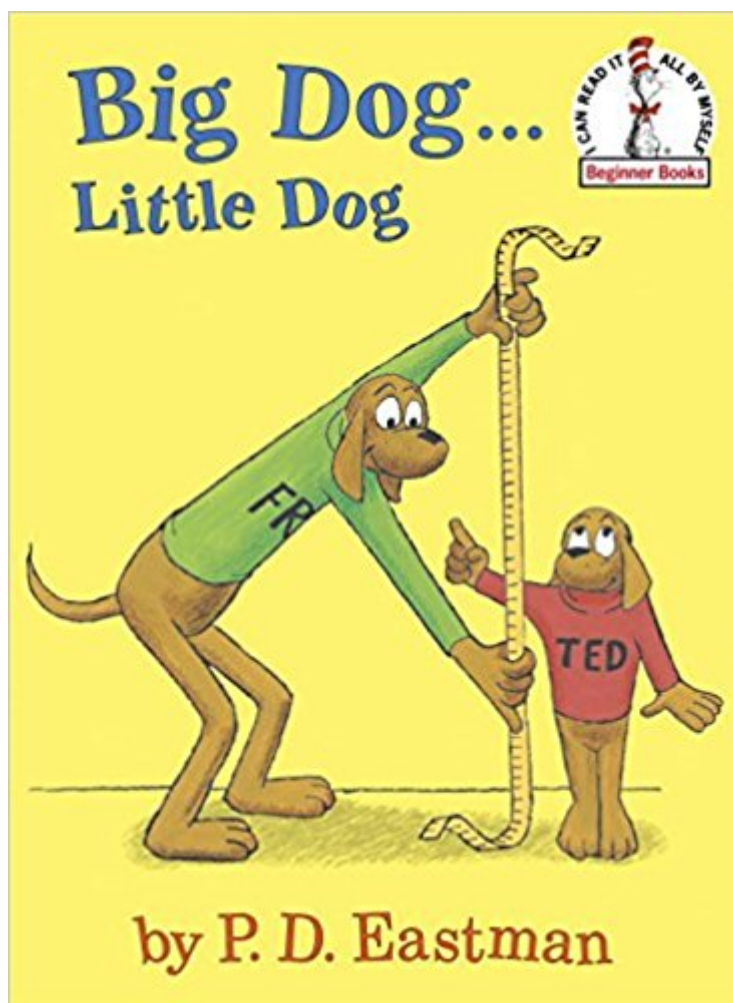

Big Dog . . . Little Dog has been reformatted into a Beginner Book to join P. D. Eastman's other classics: "Go, Dog. Go!" and "Are You My Mother?" This delightful book chronicles a day in the life of Ted and Fred-two dogs who are different in every way, but also the best of friends. An irreverent introduction to the concepts of size, color, and opposites.

P. D. Eastman was one of the stars of the Beginner Books line with beloved classics like Are You My Mother?; Go, Dog. Go!; The Best Nest; and more! From the Non-traditional book edition.

This was my 31 year old son's favorite book as a child. Now he has a baby daughter, so I was happy to find it now available in a board book for her.

My kids LOVE the 2 "big dog" books, especially this one, the original. It is cute, funny, and a book of total opposites. The kids are thoroughly entertained over and over again, especially when the friends drive their cars opposite--the kids roar every time at the fast car leaving his friend in the dust. Bonus, I find these cute dogs fun also, and the words are rhythmic and easy to read, so I look forward to reading it again when they ask, instead of cringing! The illustrations hold attention, too. They are colorful and cute--these dogs are irresistible!! There is a "little" book edition which is nice, also, but condensed. This original version cannot be improved on--this is the one you'll want!

My kids loved Fred and Ted. Despite having hundreds of other books this is one they chose the most. I believe there are other Fred and Ted books now. There weren't (that I knew of) when my kids were little. Fred and Ted are lovable!

After buying quite a few books for my toddler, a friend recommended "Go, Dog! Go!" It was an immediate hit for my 2YO. Since then I have been interested to see what the other PD Eastman creations would be like. This past month I ordered three, including this one. And as I hoped- my son loves them! He can actually turn the pages and identify with the images and I know for sure that he feels a sense of accomplishment when I commend him for "getting it right". His face lights up with excitement as he turns the pages and tells me what Ted and Fred are doing. I would definitely recommend this as an addition to any Toddler's bookshelf.
