

Great follow up novel to book 1 and I am excited for book 3! There is more magic, ships, action, romance, and the stakes are higher. If you enjoyed book 1 you will definitely enjoy book 2. This book is hard to put down! I read this in two days, which would have been one if things like sleep and work didn't get in the way. The first quarter was a bit angstier than I would like, but it goes quickly and is relevant to the story. I also couldn't help but wonder how Nile's teeth enamel and esophagus fair, but choose to believe she has a very resilient, erosion-proof body. As the story progressed, it went in a direction I didn't anticipate, mixing it well with a combination of action and political machinations. The world further expands with new characters and further character growth. I'm looking forward to seeing how the story further progresses and seeing how Nile's relationship with her magic changes.

Book 2 in the Tides series is just as gripping as the first book as readers follow Princess Nile Greysik. She's posing as an ordinary seaman aboard the warship Aurora, having run away from home and a political marriage. But when their sedate patrol route suddenly turns into a crucial battleground, Nile must choose between exposing her identity or letting her country fall to defeat. To save the ones she loves, she considers accepting the marriage proposal she'd been avoiding. It may be the only way to foil the enemy and salvage her military career. As a reader, I love these stories that remind me of a cross between Mike Shepherd's Kris Longknife series and the Horatio Hornblower saga. I can't wait for the next installment.

Good follow up to the first book in the series which I would give 3.5 stars to. Ash's adventures continue as does the great writing and enjoyable characters. This second book seems a little happier (perhaps a bit more fairy-tale-everything-works-out) than the first one - I am not sure that that is a good thing - but the story is still fun. The male lead takes a turn towards the predictable self-sacrificing sap and some new characters are a bit two-dimensional and off-the-rack but all-in-all an enjoyable read and a good solid second installment. I look forward to the third book in the series, whilst hoping it will deliver on the promise of the first one by developing unconventional characters and not simply allowing everyone to be molded into a boring stereotype.

I loved these two books and can't wait for the next story in the series. Like book 1, book 2 had numerous unexpected twists and turns. I didn't want to put the book down but I also didn't want the story to end. A fascinating exploration of multiple current issues, all wrapped up in a gripping story

with a very satisfying ending (for the time being). I love the quirky, strong-willed animals that feature in the story here and there. And the minor characters like Catsper are as intriguing as the leading characters. I hope we hear much more of him and his own story. The dialogue is incredibly skillful. We learn so much about the nature of even minor characters from just a few lines of speech. An exceptional series of books.

What a read! I was only going to read a chapter or two before going to bed. Stayed up until late, woke up early the next morning, and finished it. It was an on the edge of your seat, full of adventure and twists and turns book. Not a child's book by any stretch of the imagination due to some of the brutality found in battle or punishment meted for not following orders. Nor would I let a child read it based on some of the sexually charged situations between characters (no gratuitous sex--just too much information in the description). Having said that, that is the only fault with the book. The entire story flows smoothly and I can't wait for the next to come out!

This book was so exciting I just couldn't put it down. There is a lot of action, romance, and character development. We see how despicable Captain Rima is and he plays an extraordinary adversary. There are a lot of sweet, intense Domenic/Ash moments too. We are also introduced to Tam and Aaron, both really awesome characters and harboring a secret as great as Ash's. I just love that Ash is strong and takes matter into her own hands, and I enjoyed seeing the bond she made with her friends. Ash learns more on how to control her power, and she is finally reunited with her brother Clay. The finale where Ash and Rima face off was really exciting too.

A wonderful continuation of a much loved series by a wonderful author whom I've had the pleasure to communicate with. Her stories are action packed, magical and easy to immerse yourself into. No spoilers here. You need to read these books yourself and find the awesome enjoyment I have. I recommend all of Alex Lidell's books. Sincerely, Alan McDonald
