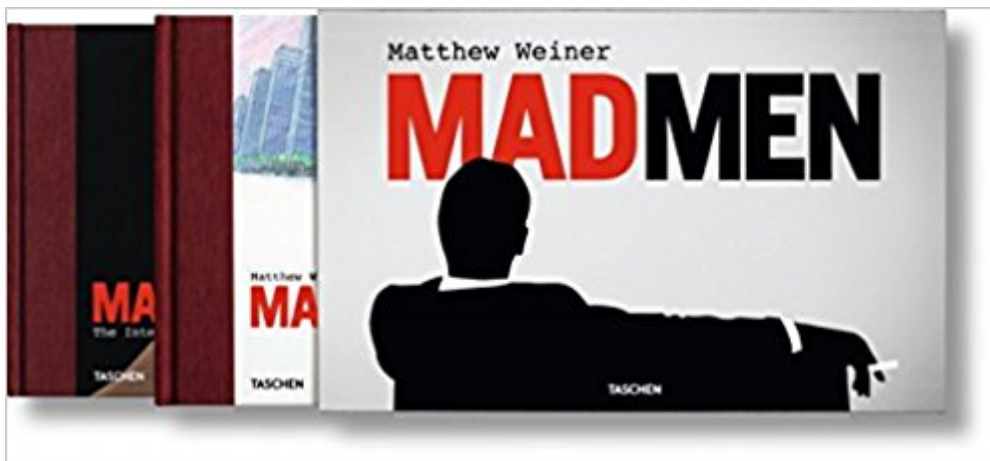

5 stars are not nearly enough for this amazing labor of love for everyone who obsessed over Mad Men and misses it terribly! First of all, it's packaged in a briefcase sized box, which is phenomenal. And you better reinforce your coffee table, because this baby is HEAVY! Volume 1 allows you to relive the show, with beautiful photos and quotes covering the show from the beginning to the very end, in 840 glossy pages. Volume 2 includes interviews and behind the scenes treasures and , while slimmer, is heavy on content. We've been waiting for this for years, and I'm thrilled to say, it as totally worth it! Christmas came early this year!!!

I'm a huge fan of Taschen books, and a huge Mad Men fan. Sadly this XL book left me underwhelmed. The biggest issue is the rather non vibrant printing, and the wonderful photos kinda look like faded snapshots off a monitor (actually snapshots would be vastly more intensely colored). SO much black ink and every photo is way too dark. There are also inaccuracies in the photo descriptions (e.g., paraphrasing, Megan on the set of her soap opera (no, it's the tv commercial for Butler Shoes)). Clearly Matt Weiner didn't proof the book before printing. I'm glad I have it because I'm such a fan but aside from its size and the great covers and packaging, this doesn't deliver its potential.
