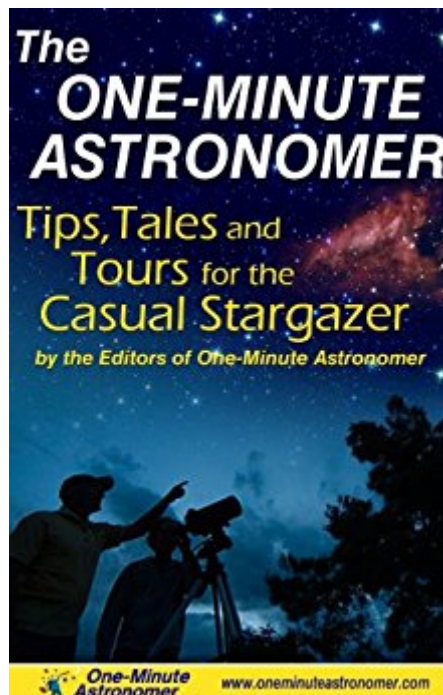




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The One-Minute Astronomer: Tips, Tales, And Tours For The Casual Stargazer
