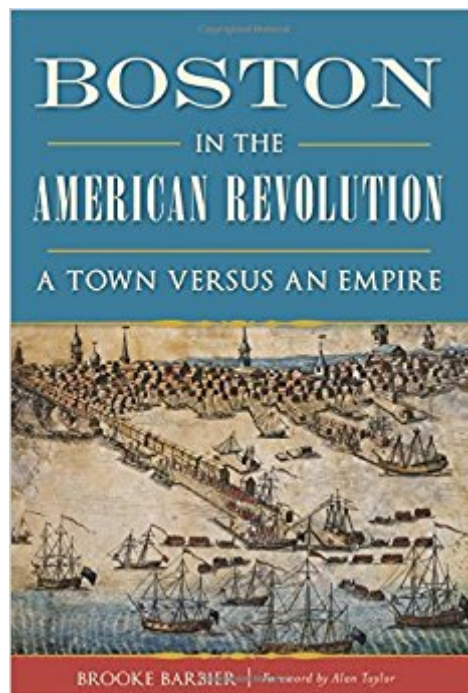




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Boston In The American Revolution: A Town Versus An Empire (History & Guide)
