

The volume's 1912 successor, *The Book of Lies*, features aphorisms and paradoxes that invoke the symbolism of Freemasonry and other traditions. *The Book of the Law* and *The Book of Lies* continue to rank among Crowley's most widely read writings. Both books have exercised a vast influence on popular culture and the practice of magic, offering fascinating glimpses into the author's mystic pursuits.

writings and the creation of his own religion, Thelema, the chief precept of which was "Do what thou wilst." Satanist, pansexual, and cult figure, Crowley exercised a powerful influence over pop culture and remains widely read.
