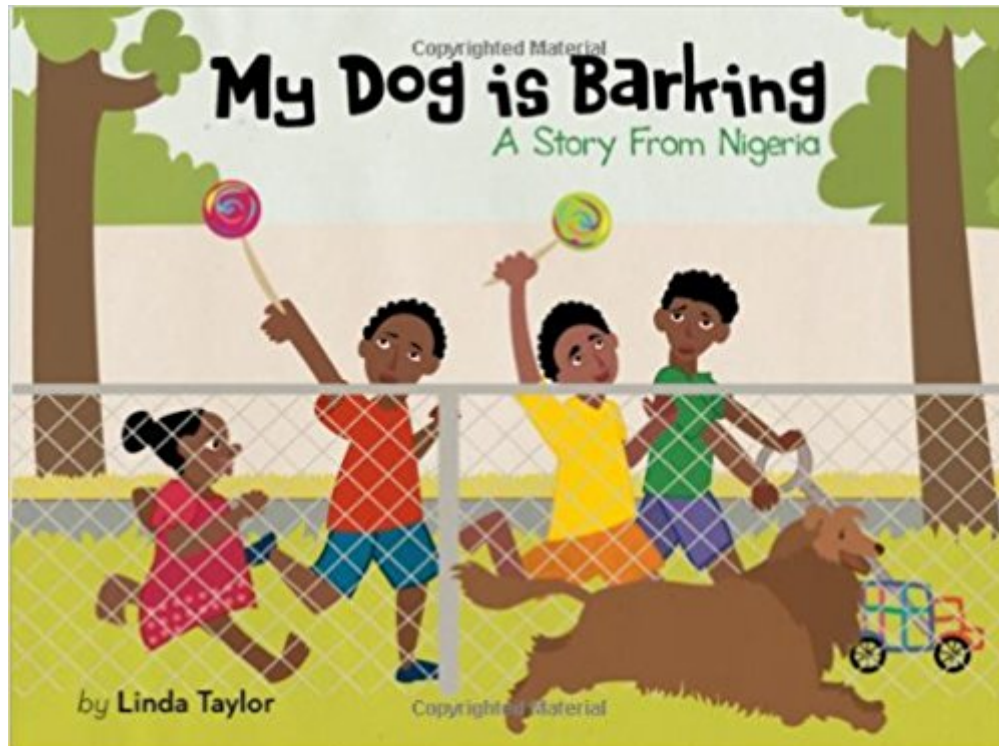

If you know Linda, you know there is always a story to tell. And tell it she does in this children's storybook about living as a missionary in Nigeria. Daily life is portrayed as seen by the family dog. If you are interested in teaching children about life in what is often seen as an "exotic" locale, buy this book. But you might just be surprised how similar life can be halfway across the world, even with all the external differences. By the way, in case you don't trust my review, my two kids loved it as well. They couldn't wait to take it to school and show their friends and teachers.

Having lived in Nigeria a few months, I could really relate to this little book. I enjoyed giving copies to my great nieces & nephews. A great book for parents to read to their children or have them read it aloud. It not only helps to introduce a different culture to the child, but gives many topics for good discussion. Such as: "Why do the women have to go to the restaurant to get their water?" Or purchase a fresh mango and serve it as a reminder of the popular fruit in Nigeria. The author did a great job in introducing the story of Jesus into this little book.

This is an excellent book for children to learn about the culture of Nigeria from the perspective of an observer in an easy to read and understand format. The author describes the daily activities of the people as if she were participating, while at the same time, integrates Biblical verses into the lives of the people. The illustrations are wonderful as well, and each page's picture relates directly to the narrative provided on that page. This is a great book for all children.
