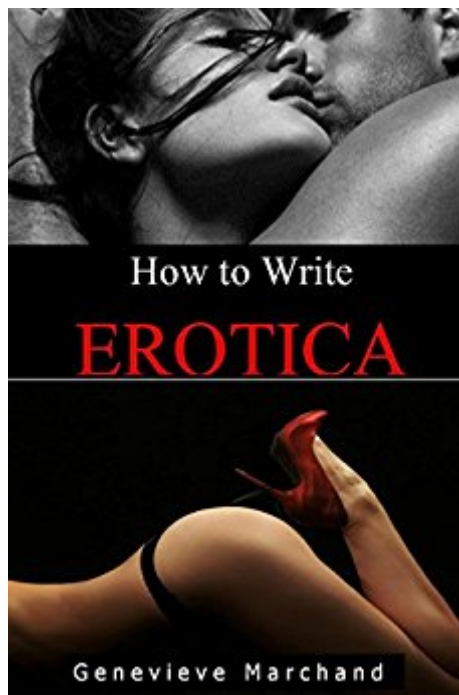

comprehensive guide you'll ever need, very detailed and on point. It provides clear explanation on choosing topics, plots, twists, developing characters and a quick overview on uploading your book for self-publishing.

I really enjoyed this book. The author is a straight shooter and doesn't mince words, which was really nice. I enjoy all the info. I look forward to read her fictional work. But for understanding the business of self-publishing, it's very helpful.

This book is rubbish. You get 3 pages from about 70 on actually writing erotica. Don't waste your money on this author's petty scam.

Wow, this book really tries hard to be a complete waste of time. Yes, it looks like there are a lot of pages so you might think, "Hey, there should be something useful here!" You'd be wrong. Let's see: 35% of the book is a glossary featuring bookbinding terms like "aqueous coating" and "blind embossing." Seriously? Most of the rest of the book is a very generic overview of books and ebooks. Did you know that books often have a table of contents? This book will tell you! There is very little to do with erotica, just a brief list of taboos (pseudo-incest, multiple partners, etc.), and a very short and obvious list of kinks. Okay, there is a short bit on taking a standard story structure and using it for a sex story, which admittedly might be useful for someone. That at least brings this book up to one star. Sigh. Thank god for Kindle Unlimited or I might have paid money for this. (And note that I read this on the Canadian site, so it might not show me as a verified purchase.)

Lots of really rudimentary stuff here about KDP publishing in general. The main thing I found helpful was when the author laid out a basic structure for an erotica story.

There is a lot of resource material in this book that I think will be very helpful to a new and even a seasoned writer. If I had any negatives it would be that I find it ironic to be reading a book about writing and find so many grammatical errors. Fortunately, that is not a deal breaker and I recommend this book to anyone wanting to enter the Erotica writing arena.

The majority of my questions were answered and excellent suggestions are provided. I just wish

that when the comment was made about not writing a romance novel that one or two sentences would have described the differences.
