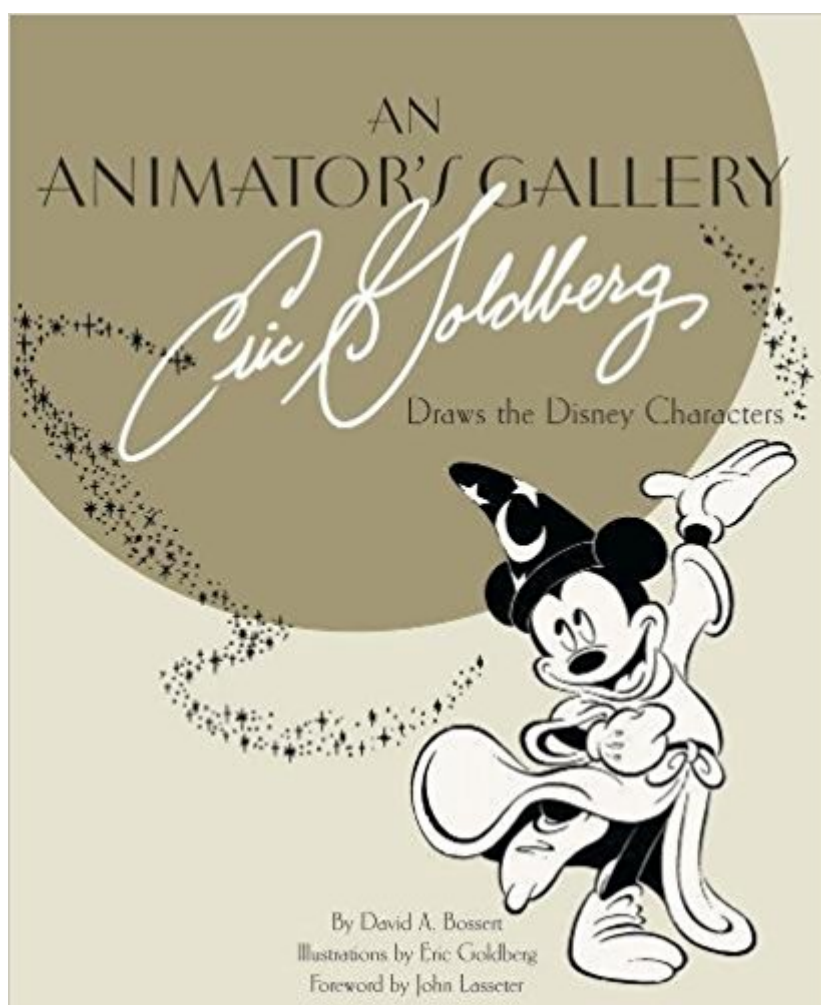

Most recently he led the hand-drawn animation team on the satirical short Get a Horse!, starring Mickey and friends, which debuted in theaters with Frozen. Before joining The Walt Disney Company in 1990, he founded and ran his own award-winning animation house, Pizazz Pictures, in London.
