

Like the other volumes in this series this volume also gives the original Sanskrit text of Aranya-kanda in Roman script, a very helpful feature. Excellent price, excellent publication.

I bought it for my 9 yrs old kid and he really loved it. This is a very nice and concise book.

This is only the third book of the Ramayana, which somebody who is not familiar with the work would be unable to guess. This is odd as Sattar has published a full version containing this section of the Ramayana which is not available for Kindle. It has no index, making it nearly useless as a reference work. The chapters marked in it do not match up with the chapters in any other edition of the Ramayana, making it difficult to compare translations. Otherwise, it is very readable and if you just want to read a good story, I would recommend buying the hard copy version that includes the entire Ramayana and enjoying it.
