During a routine naval mission to capture whales two people are murdered and a mysterious woman (Patient X), is rescued from the sea. She heals quickly, too quickly. How did she survive the Atomic Sea? She warns Avery, there are spies on the ship, working with the Octtungen; she has come to end the war. Janx is a whaler, working on the ship.
