

D. A. Carson (PhD, University of Cambridge) is research professor of New Testament at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School in Deerfield, Illinois, and is the author or editor of more than fifty books, including *The God Who Is There* and *How Long, O Lord? He is one of the founders of The Gospel Coalition and an active guest lecturer in academic and church settings around the world.*

This coming of two of his books is a handy way of taking on the Sermon on the Mount. Carson has a very informative way of helping you to understand this sermon and his additional chapters 8 through 10 are a bonus even if you are not going to cover them.

Clarity and a thorough treatment is what is expected from Mr. Carson, and he delivers. His work on this section of scripture helps to open the reader's understanding of this sermon, thereby experiencing a more full impact of what it means for us. Taking the sermon from pious platitudes to hard-edged confrontation so that we can take an honest assessment of ourselves is essential for us to know what it means to be citizen's of the kingdom of heaven.

Carson has a way of bringing common sense exegesis to what seems to be a familiar text. Through his lucid teaching, the S on the M becomes more nuanced. What makes this a more thorough study than some, is that Carson deals with the S on the M (Matt.5-7) and the aftermath of this teaching on its first listeners (8-10). I just finished this, and I am sending it as a gift. If you want to have a better grasp of the practicalities of Jesus' S on the M, get this book.

This book is a must-have if you are studying/preaching through the Sermon on the Mount. Carson is well-versed on the scholarship on this section, yet writes with great warmth. As with most of Carson's work, you will find your mind filled and your heart moved by his notes on the most significant sermon in the history of the world!

D.A. Carson is one of my favorite theologians. This is a great resource for people interested in getting deeper into the "Sermon on the Mount".

Misty Edwards, in her book, "What is the Point?" listed Carson's commentary on the Sermon on the Mount in her list of recommended commentaries on the subject. I got it to augment my own study of this aspect of Jesus' teachings. It has not disappointed. It is edifying and practical and balanced. I highly recommend it to anyone who is serious about following Jesus' life and teachings.

I was looking for a book to supplement a Sermon on the Mount study and grabbed this book. Good notes but less than half the book are on Matt 5-7 since it does cover 5-10.

This book contains Carson's book on the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7) from 1978 and his 1987 When Jesus Confronts the World on Matthew 8-10. Both books are excellent, and it's nice to have them in one volume. The original Sermon on the Mount book discussed some historical, critical, and theological questions within the main text, and Carson has now separated that material into appendices, making the main body of the text more like that of the second book. Both books originated out of sermons, and therefore they are quite accessible, yet the fact that they're from one of the foremost evangelical biblical scholars today ensures that they flow out of the best biblical scholarship. This book is an excellent place to get into this section of Matthew without the full study of a commentary and all the distractions therein. It focuses on the main theological and practical points in the text, making it useful for understanding the point of the text for the Christian life, yet it does it from someone who is a published scholar on the book of Matthew, which gives it far more

backing than slimmer studies tend to have.
