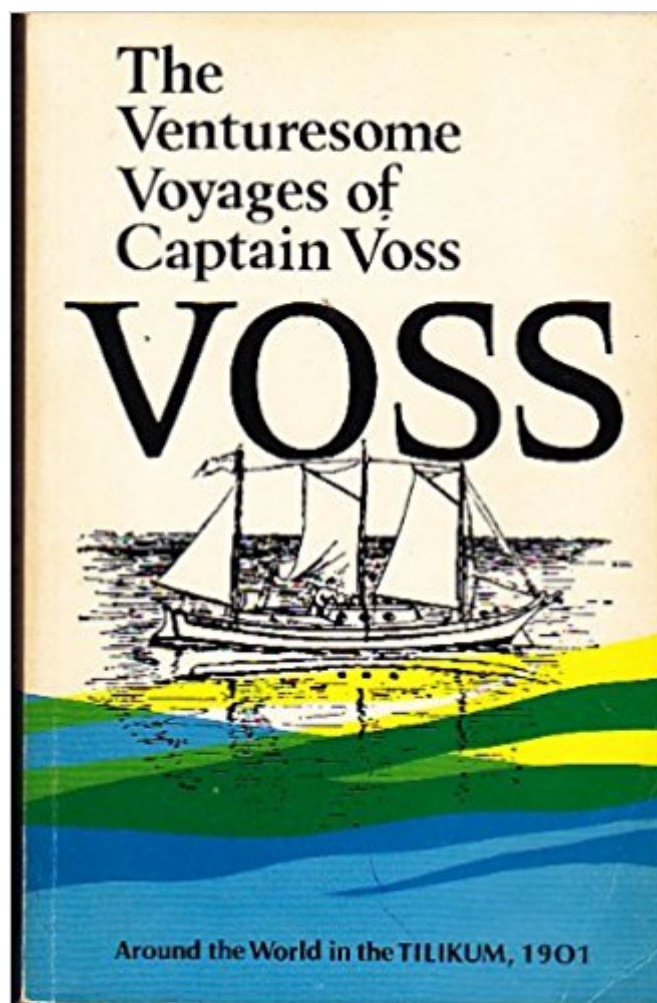

Circumnavigation in small vessels was a novelty in 1903. Captain Voss was one of the pioneers. He has a marvelous time and enjoys heaving to in gales. He is barbaric when it comes to wildlife (cultural norms have thankfully changed) but even he notes that sharks are not the monsters they are made out to be. It's a must read for armchair sailors.

The story of the Tilikum (a 38 ft dugout canoe) that sailed around the world from 1901-1904 is one of the most interesting stories you will ever read. Captain Voss makes his journey easy to read with lots of humour and adventure. The book features 3 stories but the most interesting is that of the Tilikum. Order the book, you won't be disappointed. The Tilikum can now be found at the Maritime Museum in Victoria Canada. There is another book out of print by Norman Luxton's daughter that is currently not available. I have one of the few copies.
