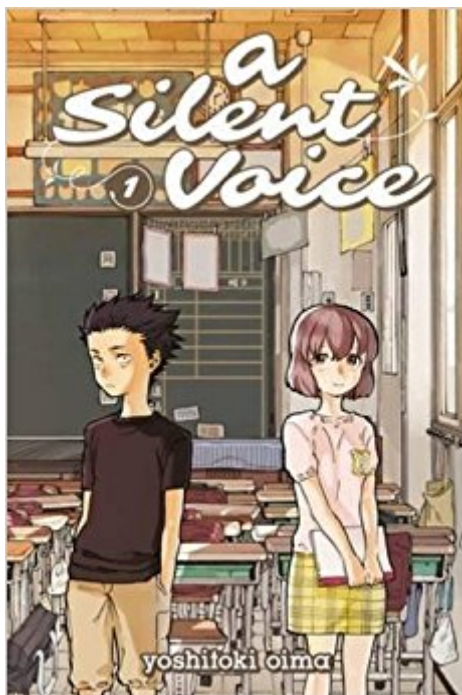

A Silent Voice gives a window to bullying that isn't present in much of today's media. Not even teenagers really understand what's happening in their own heads, but this Manga explains the thoughts, feelings, pains, and joys of growing up beautifully. A powerful message embedded in the story is that it is always possible to come back from the brink of losing hope. I would recommend this Manga to anyone.

I will admit that I initially wrote off on this manga because the way it is drawn, but as the saying goes...I was mistaken on its quality. Its story is heart wrenching. Shoya is a complete jerk in most of the volume (I hope it changes since he was 12 for most of the volume and who wasn't at that age? Look at his classmates...), but I am beginning to see his growth... I want to see what happens next for him. I like Shoko. She's very optimistic, but I feel I didn't see much development for her. I hope for more.

I read this series first, and then I started collecting it for my daughter. This manga is not filled with all sunshine and flowers. The main character is believable and flawed and you want to root for him because he's trying to do better. It's very rare that you see a character who starts out being so insensitive, realize his mistake and work so hard at trying to make it right. It makes you want to root for him. I will be gathering all of these volumes because this is an intelligent, well written story.

I've done my best to keep this a spoiler-free, short review -- the equivalent of the blurb on a book's back cover. A Silent Voice is the translation of the Japanese manga series

『静かなる声のカタチ』 (romaji: Koe no Katachi). The subject matter involves a deaf student, and some idiosyncrasies used to convey deaf communication translated

extremely well to English written text. At some points it is as if you can hear what deaf people experience. You don't need to like manga to appreciate A Silent Voice, but you do need to read the books in order. You can expect romantic tension and strong emotional connections with the characters. The story concerns a protagonist who made some poor decisions as a child (what child doesn't make poor decisions?) that had repercussions, even if he doesn't fully realize their weight. If you decide to give it a shot, you'll be glad you checked it out, and sad when it's over. If you love manga, or if you've never read manga; if you love emotional moments in movies, or if you want to begin to understand the emotional side of yourself; if you've been bullied, or if you've been the bully: this manga series is for you.
