

I am studying for the PANRE. Although I haven't taken it yet, I have used three other sources to study. I am doing well on the other three and then I got this book. The questions are harder, even poorly written in my opinion. I found myself yelling in disagreement/frustration with this book. Maybe I'm wrong. Maybe I will regret returning this book. But I could not bring myself to study from it/use it for test questions one more minute. I will try to update after I take the PANRE, to tell if I passed or not and how relevant I found this book after taking it.

The practice exams were very helpful for studying. The only thing I didn't like was that the practice exams were not made up of the same percentages of questions as the PANCE. The PANCE is supposed to have 3% questions on Heme and Infectious disease, but the practice exams consistently had around 5 to 10% of questions on these topics (I counted). Which then made me unnecessarily anxious about these subjects and I wasted some time studying them when I didn't need to. But overall the book was a great supplement to studying.

Overall I recommend this book. It goes well with Pance Prep Pearls. The level of difficulty seems appropriate to me, although I cannot say for sure since I haven't taken Pance yet. Recommendations for improvement: I agree with other reviewers that it would be better to be separated into 60 question tests like on the real exam. I assumed it must have been made into 100 question tests so that they could mirror the break down of the test (what percent of each organ system) more easily, but unfortunately that does not seem to be the case, which is the main thing wrong with this book. That is, I am using one test every couple of weeks to monitor my studying progress, and am trying to count how many I got right in each category so I know my weaknesses, but these tests don't follow the PANCE breakdown, which doesn't make any sense to me. That is, the test I just took had 11 infectious disease questions, when that is only 3% of PANCE. I wish it mirrored the breakdown of the actual test. Overall, I think it has been very helpful and would definitely still buy it.
